SUBJECT: Requirements for Youth Sports Participation

1. IAW AFMAN 34-804, "*Air Force Youth Sports*," Section 7.1., each child/youth must have a physical examination and evaluation prior to participating in youth sports programs. It is not necessary for a child/youth to have an examination for each season during the year, but each he or she must have an annual examination. In addition to physical examinations, participants in Air Force youth sports programs must have a current record of immunizations required by the American Academy of Pediatrics and the Centers for Disease Control for their age group, which should be updated and validated during the child/youth's annual physical examination. If a large quantity of physicals is required, the youth director will coordinate special arrangements with the Chief of Hospital or Clinic Services for a mass processing session for physical examinations.
2. I am requesting that a block be added to the bottom of the "Well visit" form indicating that a physical examination has been conducted, a child's immunizations record has been updated and the any physical limitations, if any, for the participant. I expect that this will reduce the run-around for parents and make the process of child/youth sports less of a hassle.
